The word of God is a deep Water

Psalm 1:1 (KJV) Blessed *is* the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

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Brethren, the Word of God is Deep Water!

Let us consider the following verses to confirm our teaching from:

Psalm 1:1 (KJV), Psalm 1:3 (KJV),

Proverbs 20:5

Isaiah 1:8 (KJV), Isaiah 5:7 (KJV)

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The word of God is a deep Water

Psalm 1:3 (KJV) And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper

The Word of God is the Counsel of God and it is Deep Water! Proverbs 20:5 (KJV) Counsel in the heart of man is like deep water; but a man of understanding will draw it out

Isaiah 1:8 (KJV) And the daughter of Zion is left as a cottage in a vineyard, as a lodge in a garden of cucumbers, as a besieged city

Isaiah 5:7 (KJV) For the vineyard of the LORD of hosts *is* the house of Israel, and the men of Judah his pleasant plant: and he looked for judgment, but behold oppression; for righteousness, but behold a cry.

Fellow beloved in Christ Jesus;

- □ You are the Garden
- □ You are the Vineyard
- □ You are the Tree
- You are the Branches
- The Word of God is the Water that waters the Garden!

Isaiah 5:7 (KJV) For the vineyard of the LORD of hosts *is* the house of Israel, and the men of Judah his pleasant plant: and he looked for judgment, but behold oppression; for righteousness, but behold a cry.

Isaiah 58:11 (KJV) And the LORD shall guide thee continually, and satisfy thy soul in drought, and make fat thy bones: and thou shalt be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters fail not.

Luke 13:18 (KJV) Then said he, Unto what is the kingdom of God like? and whereunto shall I resemble it?

Luke 13:19 (KJV) It is like a grain of mustard seed, which a man took, and cast into his garden; and it grew, and waxed a great tree; and the fowls of the air lodged in the branches of it.

John 15:5 (KJV) I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.

Jeremiah 12:10 (KJV) Many pastors have destroyed my vineyard, they have trodden my portion under foot, they have made my pleasant portion a desolate wilderness

Jeremiah 23:15 (KJV) Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts concerning the prophets; Behold, I will feed them with wormwood, and make them drink the water of gall: for from the prophets of Jerusalem is profaneness gone forth into all the land.

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Here is how Prophets/Pastors kill the vineyard and Garden of God: By the type of water they use and how they use it! If the water is filthy, the products will be filthy.

If it is false doctrine, the outcome will be the same (false believer).

Proverbs 1:23 (KJV) Turn you at my reproof: behold, I will pour out my spirit unto you, I will make known my words unto you.

Joel 2:28 (KJV) And it shall come to pass afterward, *that* I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions:

Joel 2:29 (KJV) And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit.

Acts 2:17 (KJV) And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:

Acts 2:18 (KJV) And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:

Therefore, "I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh" simply means "I will make known my words unto you"! How so?

□What does it mean when the LORD God says that "I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh"?

Does it mean some mysterious spiritual experience where people are rolling on the floor, speaking fake tongues, rolling their eyes, and jumping repeatedly as one who has fallen into a pool of ants? NO!

"I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh" simply means exactly what the LORD has already defined in Proverbs 1:23 (KJV)!
 Proverbs 1:23 (KJV) Turn you at my reproof: behold, I will pour out my spirit unto you, I will make known my words unto you.

Haggai 2:5 (KJV) *According to* the word that I covenanted with you when ye came out of Egypt, so my spirit remaineth among you: fear ye not.

John 6:63 (KJV) It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, *they* are spirit, and *they* are life.

Therefore, "I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh" simply means "I will make known my words unto you"! How so?

Because the Spirit is the Word of God and the Word of God is the Spirit of God and the Word of God is the Deep Water of God! "The words that I speak unto you, they are spirit"!

John 4:10 (KJV) Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water.

John 15:3 (KJV) Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you.

Ephesians 5:26 (KJV) That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

John 4:11 (KJV) The woman saith unto him, Sir, thou hast nothing to draw with, and the well is deep: from whence then hast thou that living water?

John 4:12 (KJV) Art thou greater than our father Jacob, which gave us the well, and drank thereof himself, and his children, and his cattle?

Here is the LORD Jesus Christ teaching clearly in unmistakable terms, that the physical water, is NOT the answer but the Spiritual, "The words that I speak unto you, they are spirit"!

John 4:13 (KJV) Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again:

John 4:14 (KJV) But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.

John 4:15 (KJV) The woman saith unto him, Sir, give me this water, that I thirst not, neither come hither to draw.

See the Woman of Samaria has understood the Water Baptism Teaching of the LORD Jesus Christ, and she is now asking for the true Deep Water of God!

John 4:21 (KJV) Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father.

John 4:22 (KJV) Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews.

Secondly, the LORD Jesus Christ is teaching the Woman of Samaria, that the correct Water is the Spiritual baptism that is accomplished, NOT in any physical place, but IN SPIRIT AND IN TRUTH, meaning in the Word of God, THE SPIRIT AND TRUTH are the Word of God!

John 4:23 (KJV) But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.

John 4:24 (KJV) God *is* a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship *him* in spirit and in truth.

Psalm 42:7 (KJV) Deep calleth unto deep at the noise of thy waterspouts: all thy waves and thy billows are gone over me.

Proverbs 27:19 (KJV) As in water face answereth to face, so the heart of man to man.

Proverbs 27:17 (KJV) Iron sharpeneth iron; so a man sharpeneth the countenance of his friend.

Romans 8:1 (KJV) *There is* therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Romans 8:2 (KJV) For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Romans 8:3 (KJV) For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

Romans 8:4 (KJV) That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Romans 8:5 (KJV) For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

Romans 8:6 (KJV) For to be carnally minded *is* death; but to be spiritually minded *is* life and peace.

Romans 8:7 (KJV) Because the carnal mind *is* enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

Romans 8:8 (KJV) So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

Romans 8:9 (KJV) But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

- In other words, if God is Spirit, then we must worship him in spirit and should not focus on the physical like water alone. God is spirit and we must seek Him in spirit.
- So, it makes sense only when you add spirit to Spirit, or when you add flesh to flesh! Those who add spirit to Spirt are the true children of God. Romans 8:13 (KJV) reveals that!

Romans 8:10 (KJV) And if Christ *be* in you, the body *is* dead because of sin; but the Spirit *is* life because of righteousness.

Romans 8:11 (KJV) But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

Romans 8:12 (KJV) Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.

Romans 8:13 (KJV) For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

John 4:9 (KJV) Then saith the woman of Samaria unto him, How is it that thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Samaria? for the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans.

John 4:10 (KJV) Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water.

- Here is the LORD Jesus Christ showing you that the spiritual water is the living Word!
- Only the water that God Almighty gives is the living water according to John 4:10 (KJV)!

John 4:11 (KJV) The woman saith unto him, Sir, thou hast nothing to draw with, and the well is deep: from whence then hast thou that living water?

John 4:12 (KJV) Art thou greater than our father Jacob, which gave us the well, and drank thereof himself, and his children, and his cattle?

John 4:13 (KJV) Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again:

John 4:14 (KJV) But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.

Mark 12:27 (KJV) He is not the God of the dead, but the God of the living: ye therefore do greatly err.

Luke 20:38 (KJV) For he is not a God of the dead, but of the living: for all live unto him.

Then, here is the LORD Jesus Christ showing you that God Almighty is NOT the God of the dead but the God of the living, meaning that, you cannot go and take a dead and attach it to the Living God, because *dead* and *living* do NOT go together as the LORD Jesus Christ revealed in Mark 12:27 (KJV) and in Luke 20:38 (KJV)!

John 4:10 (KJV) Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water.

So, then, if God is the Living God, and God's water is the Living water that only Jesus Christ can give (John 4:10 (KJV)), and you focus only on baptismal with water and neglect the living waters, (Word of God- Living God) who is our LORD Jesus Christ. As already revealed to you in Mark 12:27 (KJV) and in Luke 20:38 (KJV) that dead water and the Living God DO NOT go together?

Matthew 28:18 (KJV) And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

Matthew 28:19 (KJV) Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

Matthew 28:20 (KJV) Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, *even* unto the end of the world. Amen.

In conclusion of this podcast, I will like to emphasize that, when the LORD Jesus Christ gave this command in Matthew 28:18-20 (KJV), HE command us to "baptize them spiritually by pouring the Word of God unto them"! Remember God talking in Romans 8:13 (KJV) "For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die" and remember also, that physical filthy river or pool water, can not replace the spirit. It is flesh!

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Joel 2:29 (KJV) And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit.

- Specifically, the LORD Jesus Christ commanded to be "baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost"
- Jesus also made it clear how to do it: HE gave the methodology to perform that command saying: "teach all nations"!
- Therefore, when you are "teaching all nations the Word of God", what you are actually doing is that you are pouring the Spirit of God on them!
 As am doing through this live podcast.


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Acts 2:18 (KJV) And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:
