John 4:10 (KJV) Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water

Matthew 12:9 (KJV) And when he was departed thence, he went into their synagogue:

Matthew 12:10 (KJV) And, behold, there was a man which had his hand withered. And they asked him, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath days? that they might accuse him.

Matthew 12:11 (KJV) And he said unto them, What man shall there be among you, that shall have one sheep, and if it fall into a pit on the sabbath day, will he not lay hold on it, and lift it out?

Matthew 12:12 (KJV) How much then is a man better than a sheep? Wherefore it is lawful to do well on the sabbath days.

Matthew 12:13 (KJV) Then saith he to the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched it forth; and it was restored whole, like as the other.


Matthew 12:14 (KJV) Then the Pharisees went out, and held a council against him, how they might destroy him.



Matthew 21:23 (KJV) And when he was come into the temple, the chief priests and the elders of the people came unto him as he was teaching, and said, By what authority doest thou these things? and who gave thee this authority?

Matthew 21:24 (KJV) And Jesus answered and said unto them, I also will ask you one thing, which if ye tell me, I in like wise will tell you by what authority I do these things.

Matthew 21:25 (KJV) The baptism of John, whence was it? from heaven, or of men? And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say unto us, Why did ye not then believe him?



Matthew 21:26 (KJV) But if we shall say, Of men; we fear the people; for all hold John as a prophet.

Matthew 21:27 (KJV) And they answered Jesus, and said, We cannot tell. And he said unto them, Neither tell I you by what authority I do these things.

Matthew 22:34 (KJV) But when the Pharisees had heard that he had put the Sadducees to silence, they were gathered together.



Matthew 22:35 (KJV) Then one of them, which was a lawyer, asked him a question, tempting him, and saying,

Matthew 22:36 (KJV) Master, which is the great commandment in the law?

Matthew 22:37 (KJV) Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy mind.



Matthew 22:38 (KJV) This is the first and great commandment.

Matthew 22:39 (KJV) And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

Matthew 22:40 (KJV) On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

**Exodus 3:13 (KJV)** And Moses said unto God, Behold, *when* I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, The God of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, What *is* his name? what shall I say unto them?

**Exodus 3:14 (KJV)** And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

**Exodus 3:15 (KJV)** And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this *is* my name for ever, and this *is* my memorial unto all generations.

Acts 19:6 (KJV) And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.

Acts 19:7 (KJV) And all the men were about twelve.




**Deuteronomy 6:6 (KJV)** And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart:

**Deuteronomy 6:9 (KJV)** And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates.


