




Ezekiel 14:14 (KJV) Though these three men, Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, they should deliver but their own souls by their righteousness, saith the Lord GOD.

Ezekiel 14:20 (KJV) Though Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, as I live, saith the Lord GOD, they shall deliver neither son nor daughter; they shall but deliver their own souls by their righteousness.



Daniel 4:27 (KJV) Wherefore, O king, let my counsel be acceptable unto thee, and break off thy sins by righteousness, and thine iniquities by shewing mercy to the poor; if it may be a lengthening of thy tranquillity.

Matthew 8:16 (KJV) When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick:

Mark 1:39 (KJV) And he preached in their synagogues throughout all Galilee, and cast out devils.



Matthew 9:22 (KJV) But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.

Matthew 17:20 (KJV) And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.



- Ezekiel 18:28 (KJV) Because he considereth, and turneth away from all his transgressions that he hath committed, he shall surely live, he shall not die.
- **Ezekiel 33:12 (KJV)** Therefore, thou son of man, say unto the children of thy people, The righteousness of the righteous shall not deliver him in the day of his transgression: as for the wickedness of the wicked, he shall not fall thereby in the day that he turneth from his wickedness; neither shall the righteous be able to live for his *righteousness* in the day that he sinneth.



- Lamentations 2:14 (KJV) Thy prophets have seen vain and foolish things for thee: and they have not discovered thine iniquity, to turn away thy captivity; but have seen for thee false burdens and causes of banishment.
- John 8:10 (KJV) When Jesus had lifted up himself, and saw none but the woman, he said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee?
- John 8:11 (KJV) She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.



- Acts 3:19 (KJV) Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;
- Romans 10:9 (KJV) That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.
- Romans 10:10 (KJV) For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.



- John 4:16 (KJV) Jesus saith unto her, Go, call thy husband, and come hither.
- John 4:17 (KJV) The woman answered and said, I have no husband. Jesus said unto her, Thou hast well said, I have no husband:
- John 4:18 (KJV) For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband: in that saidst thou truly.
- John 5:14 (KJV) Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.



Acts 8:22 (KJV) Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee.

Acts 8:23 (KJV) For I perceive that thou art in the gall of bitterness, and *in* the bond of iniquity.



- Mark 9:25 (KJV) When Jesus saw that the people came running together, he rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, Thou dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him.
- Mark 9:26 (KJV) And the spirit cried, and rent him sore, and came out of him: and he was as one dead; insomuch that many said, He is dead.
- Mark 9:27 (KJV) But Jesus took him by the hand, and lifted him up; and he arose.
- Mark 16:17 (KJV) And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;



Matthew 28:19 (KJV) Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

Matthew 28:20 (KJV) Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen.






HOW MANY MEN SHOULD HOLD DOWN A VIOLENT PERSON FOR DELIVERANCE?



- Psalm 33:16 (KJV) There is no king saved by the multitude of an host: a mighty man is not delivered by much strength.
- Psalm 107:20 (KJV) He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered
- *them* from their destructions.
- Zechariah 4:6 (KJV) Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts.



- Mark 9:25 (KJV) When Jesus saw that the people came running together, he rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, *Thou* dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him.
- Mark 9:26 (KJV) And the spirit cried, and rent him sore, and came out of him: and he was as one dead; insomuch that many said, He is dead.
- Mark 9:27 (KJV) But Jesus took him by the hand, and lifted him up; and he arose.



- Mark 5:1 (KJV) And they came over unto the other side of the sea, into the country of the Gadarenes.
- Mark 5:2 (KJV) And when he was come out of the ship, immediately there met him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit,
- Mark 5:3 (KJV) Who had his dwelling among the tombs; and no man could bind him, no, not with chains:



- Mark 5:4 (KJV) Because that he had been often bound with fetters and chains, and the chains had been plucked asunder by him, and the fetters broken in pieces: neither could any *man* tame him.
- Mark 5:5 (KJV) And always, night and day, he was in the mountains, and in the tombs, crying, and cutting himself with stones.
- Mark 5:6 (KJV) But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped him,



- Mark 5:7 (KJV) And cried with a loud voice, and said, What have I to do with thee, Jesus, thou Son of the most high God? I adjure thee by God, that thou torment me not.
- Mark 5:8 (KJV) For he said unto him, Come out of the man, thou unclean spirit.
- Mark 5:9 (KJV) And he asked him, What is thy name? And he answered, saying, My name is Legion: for we are many.
- Mark 5:10 (KJV) And he besought him much that he would not send them away out of the country.



- Mark 5:11 (KJV) Now there was there nigh unto the mountains a great herd of swine feeding.
- Mark 5:12 (KJV) And all the devils besought him, saying, Send us into the swine, that we may enter into them.
- Mark 5:13 (KJV) And forthwith Jesus gave them leave. And the unclean spirits went out, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the sea, (they were about two thousand;) and were choked in the sea.
- Mark 5:14 (KJV) And they that fed the swine fled, and told it in the city, and in the country. And they went out to see what it was that was done.



- Acts 16:16 (KJV) And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying:
- Acts 16:17 (KJV) The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation.
- Acts 16:18 (KJV) And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.




Acts 16:19 (KJV) And when her masters saw that the hope of their gains was gone, they caught Paul and Silas, and drew them into the marketplace unto the rulers,



- Acts 19:13 (KJV) Then certain of the vagabond Jews, exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth.
- Acts 19:14 (KJV) And there were seven sons of one Sceva, a Jew, and chief of the priests, which did so.

Acts 19:15 (KJV) And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?




Acts 19:16 (KJV) And the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.

Acts 19:17 (KJV) And this was known to all the Jews and Greeks also dwelling at Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, and the name of the Lord Jesus was magnified.



- Matthew 8:8 (KJV) The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.
- Acts 14:8 (KJV) And there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a cripple from his mother's womb, who never had walked:
- Acts 14:9 (KJV) The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had faith to be healed,



- Mark 7:24 (KJV) And from thence he arose, and went into the borders of Tyre and Sidon, and entered into an house, and would have no man know *it*: but he could not be hid.
- Mark 7:25 (KJV) For a certain woman, whose young daughter had an unclean spirit, heard of him, and came and fell at his feet:
- Mark 7:26 (KJV) The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she besought him that he would cast forth the devil out of her daughter.
- Mark 7:30 (KJV) And when she was come to her house, she found the devil gone out, and her daughter laid upon the bed.



Mark 7:27 (KJV) But Jesus said unto her, Let the children first be filled: for it is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast *it* unto the dogs.

Mark 7:28 (KJV) And she answered and said unto him, Yes, Lord: yet the dogs under the table eat of the children's crumbs.

Mark 7:29 (KJV) And he said unto her, For this saying go thy way; the devil is gone out of thy daughter.




1 Timothy 4:16 (KJV) Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee.

James 1:21 (KJV) Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.
