




SPIRITUAL INTERPRETATION OF THE LORD'S PRAYER!




UNDERSTANDING THE DEEPER MEANINGS!


- Matthew 6:5 (KJV) And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites *are*: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward
- □ 1 Samuel 1:12 (KJV) And it came to pass, as she continued praying before the LORD, that Eli marked her mouth.
- □ 1 Samuel 1:13 (KJV) Now Hannah, she spake in her heart; only her lips moved, but her voice was not heard: therefore Eli thought she had been drunken.



Matthew 6:7 (NIV): "And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words."

Matthew 6:13 (NIV): "And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one."




OUR FATHER WHO ART IN HEAVEN
